We have a full room of eager young mothers and their partners. Under the faithful eye of staff, our girls are able to receive education from a Public Health nurse and prepare for labour & delivery and parenthood.

Elisha House has been running YPN since 2015. Over the years we have transitioned through many different courses, including life skills, parenting, healthy relationships, discipline, etc.. Elisha House has been a beacon of hope for many people. It doesn't matter if a client needs a helping hand through her challenging pregnancy or needs to talk through her options, we have been an open door in the community of Welland. As we look upon the last thirty years, many things have changed. Whether a client walked through the door in 1988 or walks through it today, each client, regardless of their circumstances, is able to come in and receive support, guidance and hope.
